We think not.

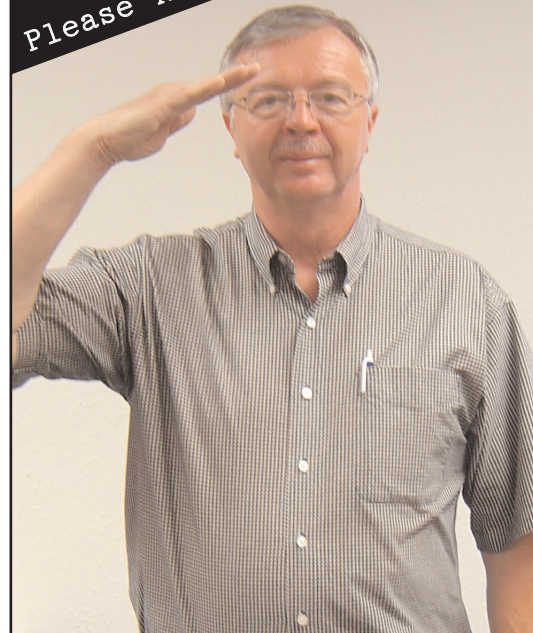
An unofficial Russ Haines for President Committee member says, "A Russ Haines promise is a Russ Haines promise kept. This will make Russ stand out in the White House."
